They are as near ABSOLUTELY WATERPROOF as it is possible to make any fabric composed of cotton or wool. It is a well-known fact that no garment made of cotton or wool cloth, IS ABSOLUTELY WATERPROOF UNDER ANY AND ALL CONDITIONS; only rubber or oil skins will meet these requirements.

"Duxbak" Garments are made from a soft pliable piece of cotton fabric of extra fine construction, made especially for that purpose. It is absolutely the best, finest and most expensive piece of cloth used today in the manufacture of hunting clothes. Before being made into garments, all materials are carefully and thoroughly proofed

by the well known Priestly "Cravenette" Process of Water-proofing—which adds greatly to the rain-proof qualities of the garments. Indeed, it is a truism that "Duxbak" "sheds water like a duck's back." Whether in a heavy down pour, a driving nor'easter or a penetrating drizzle, the result is the same.

This "Cravenetting" is not a cloth, as some think, but a process of water-proofing which we absolutely control on all Sportsman's Clothing throughout the United States. This process is identical with that used in the fine high-grade rain coats for men and womens' wear so widely advertised and extensively known throughout the whole civilized world. The Cravenette Label as shown on inside of front and back cover of catalogue can only be used on "Duxbak" goods, and when so used, guarantees to the wearer the best combination of cloth, design, make, and rain-proof qualities, that money and skill can produce.

The great utility of "Duxbak" Garments does not end with being rain-proof. They are light and soft, comfortable and well-looking. The nature of the fabric permits of perfect ventilation, so they can be worn

in sunshine as well as in rain, and you are not ashamed of being seen when you start out or come home.

Soft and smooth, entirely odorless, carefully fashioned and thoroughly tailored, a "Duxbak" suit is as light and easy as any clothes you ever wore. For the hotel fisherman who has to consider his appearance; for the man in camp, who takes life as it comes in boat or brush; for the man on the trail, who sleeps in the open, there is no form of covering at any cost that affords such absolute protection, such conscious comfort, as a Duxbak Suit. There is no rubber or paraffine in the goods, therefore the cloth does not get hard; it can't crack, peel, nor blister, and the seams will not open. ## Duxbak Hunting

### Coats

ARE fashioned and made as well as any tailor can make them. It is made throughout the entire body of double thickness—that is, the interlining is of the same Rainproof material as the outside.

Under the arms is a bellows-shaped gusset, ventilated with eyelets, permitting the air to get in where air is most needed, and allowing the arm free action with rod or with gun.

The collar and wrists of the coat are faced for comfort with fine soft corduroy of appropriate color, the wrists being provided with adjustable straps so they can be tightened when necessary to keep out the water and cold.

There are pockets for everything, from matches to game.

Two large cut-in pockets on each side protected by flaps; one smaller cut-in pocket and match pocket at left breast, also protected by flap, besides a patch whistle pocket. Inside game pockets throughout entire body, both front and rear.

Entrance to inside front game pockets are at front facings, and back game pockets at side seams, as shown in cut.

On the shoulder there is a reinforced gun cap right where the breech rests, while the upper arm is double thickness from shoulder to cuff, which gives extra protection where most needed.

The entire coat is designed with the utmost thought and consideration by men who "have hit the trail" and "followed the water" and know from experience what sportsmen need.

**A** PPEALS to those who do not care for the regulation style Hunting Coat and who wish a more dressy appearing garment. Our Norfolk Coat has the usual plaits down back and front and belt at waist. Owing to the front plaits, the pockets must be put in different than the regular coat shown on page 5.

The Norfolk is cut with square corners at front, has two outside patch pockets with overlapping flaps, one outside whistle pocket at left breast and inside game pocket running around the entire body with entrance through inside facing as shown in opposite cut. Like all "Duxbak" Coats it is interlined throughout the entire body with same material as outside—double upper sleeve from shoulder to cuff, ventilating gusset under arm—Corduroy faced adjustable cuff, etc.

## **Duxbak Sportsmen's Pants**

**L**IKE the Coat, are made with every thought to the comfort, convenience and appearance of the wearer. They are shaped like a pair of trousers and not like a pair of bags. The seat is protected with a double thickness for the benefit of the man, who, at times, has "Fisherman's Luck." The knees are reinforced with an extra thickness where the wear and dampness comes. As to pockets, Duxbak Pants are well favored. There is a watch pocket that will keep your time-piece dry and well protected; two side pockets, both deep and generous; two hip pockets with flaps for the "short-arm" or the "bait"; belt loops for the belt and buttons for the suspenders.

**Duxbak Knee Pant**

**F**OR the Sportsman who does not care for long trousers, we recommend the Knee or Knickerbocker Garment shown on opposite page. When worn with the leggings as shown in cut, together with coat and Hat, they make an ideal Hunting or Outing Suit. The Pants are finished with double front and double seat—side and hip pockets, same as the regular trousers, except that bottom is finished with a cuff three inches wide, fitted with two nickel buckles and adjustable straps so that cuff may be buckled tightly around calf. They are cut large and full at seat and over knee to insure ample ease and comfort.

We also make the riding style of breeches.

Take measure of Knee and Riding Pants same as for ordinary long Pant. We make the proper allowance for knee point.

The brim is about three inches wide, with a graceful roll, affording adequate shade, and is interlined with soft, French canvas which keeps it in shape and adds to its durability.

**I**S just the proper thing for the duck blinds and other exposed places. The crown is about  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in. high, lined throughout with fine mercerized twill. A  $2\frac{1}{4}$  in. visor gives ample shade for the eyes. The cape or band is 8 in. wide or deep at the back and so shaped to fit down over the coat collar to keep out the wind and rain and is adjusted to tie under the chin if desired. It is lined with fine Corduroy, which is softer and warmer to the skin than "Duxbak" cloth. When not worn opened out, it can, by a neat double fold, be tied up on the cap as shown in lower cut on page 14. This cap is made with the same care and neatness as all other "Duxbak" Goods and we can guarantee its perfect satisfaction.
