Duxbak

STYLE No. 10—Duxbak Hunting Coat is lined throughout with the same Duxbak cloth as the outside. Front and back entrances to game pockets. Doubleshell pockets on each side. Collar and cuffs faced with soft corduroy.

STYLE No. 71—Duxbak Trousers. Cut and made as a sportsman would want them. Knee and seat lined with an extra thickness of Duxbak cloth. Extra large, roomy pockets. Those on the hips have button flaps.

STYLE No. 54—Duxbak "Quick Action" Shell Vest has 32 loops so made that shells may be easily withdrawn but will not slip out by accident. A non-elastic cord is sewn into the top of the loop and strong elastic on the bottom. Made in 12, 16 and 20 gauges.

STYLE No. 59—Same as above with 48 loops.

Hat or Cap as preferred.

STYLE No. 11—Duxbak Norfolk. Lined throughout with Duxbak cloth. Entrance to game pockets is inside front of coat. Fly-book pocket on inside. Large outside pocket on each side. Collar and cuffs faced with soft corduroy.

STYLE No. 70—Duxbak Riding Style Breeches. Laced from below knee to ankle. Double on seat and knee. Hip pockets with button flaps.

STYLE No. 2-45—Duxbak Puttees. As shown with strap winding around leg and fastening at top. In color 2 only.

Hat or Cap as preferred.

STYLE No. 12—Duxbak Duck-shooter's Coat is ideal for cold, windy, exposed places. It is lined throughout with a good heavy flannel and is interlined with a water-proof slicker. Six inch collar faced with soft corduroy. Slash pockets conveniently placed as shown. Inside game pocket and outside shell pockets. Not only as a hunting coat but as a driving garment it will give excellent service.

STYLE No. 73—Duxbak Duck-shooter's Pant is also lined throughout with flannel and the double seat and knee are interlined with slicker. Goes well with the coat and makes a great outfit for zero weather.

Hat or Cap as selected but STYLE B shown herewith is especially good.



Duxbak Engineer's Coat

STYLE No. 14—The Duxbak Engineer's Coat is designed to give to the man in the field every convenience in the way of pocket room and to protect him from the inclemencies of weather that his occupation compels him to face.

Four large pockets for note books—made bellows style for service; 12 x 12 pocket across back; pencil pockets inside patch pocket; entire body of coat is a pocket and may be used as such.

Collar and cuffs are faced with soft corduroy. Entire coat of a double thickness of Duxbak cloth.

Laced bottom or regular Duxbak Trousers and your choice of Hat or Cap completes a dandy outfit for field work.



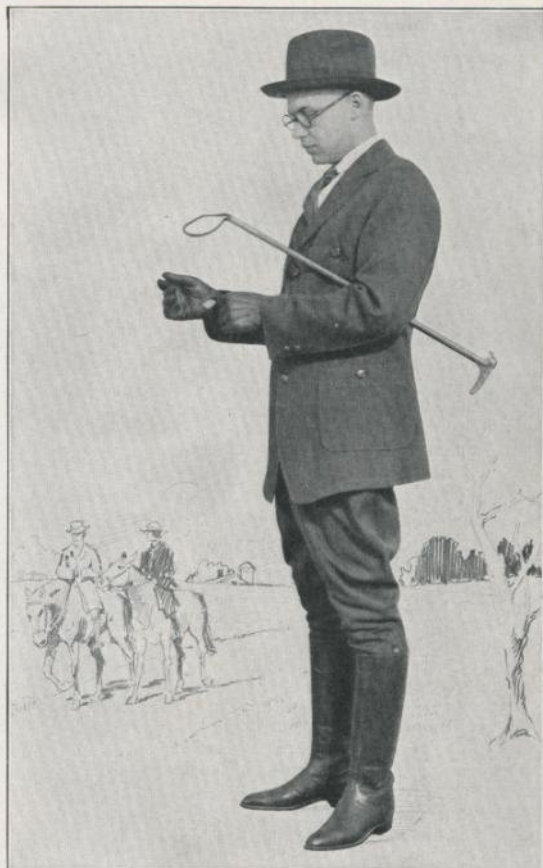
Utica Golf and Country Suit

STYLE No. 28—Coat. As the illustration shows, this is a good model for the links or for the car. Attached belt and bellows at shoulders make a snappy and comfortable finish. Yoke and sleeves lined.

STYLE No. 80—Knickers. Finished with adjustable cuff. One of the season's best models.

STYLE No. 99—Trousers. Cut and made on our best model, they will surely please you.

STYLE No. 28—Coat which is so well adapted to outing wear is especially good in this outfit. Made in many fabrics but the season's best are whipcords and gabardines, of which we carry a good assortment.

STYLE No. 83—Saddle Breeches. Tailored on smart lines and of attractive materials. Inside patch of same material. Fitted button calf.

STYLE N Hat goes well with this model.

What is Duxbak?

DUXBAK cloth is a strong, serviceable, specially constructed material, known in the trade as Army Duck. It is woven to our specifications which have been developed to secure a cloth that will be soft and pliable, yet of such character as to make satisfactory rain-proofing entirely practical. This cloth must also be of sufficient tensile strength to insure wearing qualities such as the strenuous demands of sportsmen are sure to put upon it. Duxbak is just such a material.

Duxbak Garments

Duxbak garments are designed by sportsmen for sportsmen. Into each goes the practical knowledge of the exacting requirements that sportsmen will make of it before the garment is accepted as an indispensable part of his equipment. That Duxbak has been so accepted by the leading sportsmen for many years, is evidence of successful accomplishment.

All Duxbak Coats are made of a double thickness of Duxbak cloth. This is done for two purposes—first, that adequate protection may be insured the wearer from wet and exposure, and second, that a game pocket of ample capacity may be provided. This rule is not in any case deviated from by us.

Duxbak Trousers and Breeches are reinforced at seat and knee with an extra thickness of Duxbak cloth to give protection where most needed. This reinforcement is placed on the inside and does not detract from the appearance of the garment.

All Duxbak garments are made extra strong where strength is a prime requisite. They will do their job and do it well.

Rain-Proofing

Duxbak will stand any ordinary rain for about as long a time as you would want to stay out in it. Duxbak is as nearly water-proof as it is possible to make any fabric of this kind. It is not absolutely water-proof and is sold with that understanding. You will be surprised, however, at what Duxbak will stand.

STYLE No. 01—Men's Norfolk Jacket makes a serviceable, good looking garment for warm weather wear. As the illustration shows, it is made to look well and our designer has seen to it that it is comfortable as well. Two ample pockets will hold plenty of conveniences.

STYLE No. 75—Riding Breeches are a popular style. No reinforcements at knee but the seat is doubled to give added protection. Laced from below knee to ankle.

STYLE No. 76—Kamp-it Trousers are made on our best pattern and finished nicely. A neat, attractive summer garment.

Men's Hats

STYLE A—Light weight, cool and comfortable. Well ventilated.

STYLE B—Duck-shooter's Cap. For cold and exposed places. Wide corduroy faced band ties under chin, giving perfect protection. Made in Duxbak only.

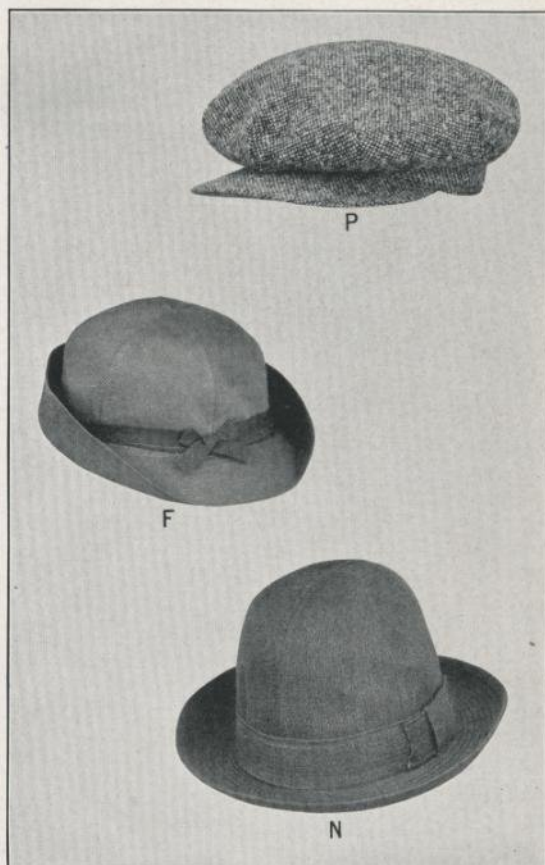
STYLE D—Deer-stalker's Cap. One-half of crown may be turned back, exposing a bright red flannel as a protection when hunting. Inside band for cold weather.

STYLE E—Golf Cap. A neat and useful style.

STYLE H—Naval Reserve Hat. Has good depth of crown and is a fine style for general outing wear.

STYLE R—Deer-stalker's Hat-Cap. Like the STYLE F shown on the following page, except that it has red flannel.

Men's Hats

STYLE F—Hat-Cap. One of the best for use in the woods. Sets close to head and is not easily brushed off. Duxbak has an inside pull-down band. Kamp-it has not.

STYLE N—Soft Hat. A fine knockabout hat. Made in any of our materials.

STYLE P—Cap. Large shape, well trimmed, and very good looking. Is made in any of our materials.

STYLE No. 18—Norfolk Jacket. Made of a double thickness of Duxbak cloth. Has an inside opening in front of coat, giving access to large inside pocket. Collar and cuffs faced with soft corduroy. Two large outside pockets.

STYLE No. 77—Hiking Breeches. Cut on good lines and are comfortable as well. Two side and one hip pocket. Lace from knee to ankle.

STYLE No. 08—Ladies' Coat. Cut on straight lines that are extremely popular. Four large pockets are handy and add much to the appearance of the garment.

STYLE No. 69—Knickers are one of the season's best. Fit and appearance are assured by our experience in making this style of garment. Adjustable cuffs.
